Senior Scholarships: We have scholarships available to our student PTSA seniors. We are thankful for our partnership with NCPS and the donations of parents in order to continue these scholarships every year. This program is 100% dependent on donated funds and support from this fundraiser.

College & Career: We have beefed up our offerings for College & Career support for our students. Not only do we have the Mock SAT and ACT Testing and FREE Parent/Student Information Workshops, we have added Student Workshops which allow our students opportunities to actually accomplish portions of the application process. We have negotiated reduced prices and we cover the facility fee required in order to present these workshops. We also have added an SAT Summer Test Prep Course.

Classroom Grants: We have established a Classroom Grant which allows us to accept requests from educators at ACHS to help them defray costs associated with classroom instruction, new ideas for classroom projects, or just overall enhancement of the teaching they do in their classrooms. Our goal is to provide small amounts of funding so our educators can think of new and innovative ways to enhance the learning in their classrooms for our students.

Scorpion Community: The goal of this committee is to be there for our students. By supporting Red Ribbon Week, Finals Treats, supporting students in need (school supplies, spirit-wear, school events, etc.) and those identified youth who just need to feel part of our wonderful ACHS Community.

Staff Appreciation/Hospitality: Yes, we do seek the support of our volunteers for donations of food items, but it takes a lot more to show our staff how much we appreciate them through our four treat days and two luncheons we provide.
